Bujumbura (Burundi): 11-18 juillet 1994
July 11-18, 1994

PREMIERE CIRCULAIRE FIRST CIRCULAR

Lors du 1^{er} symposium de Palynologie africaine qui a eu lieu à Rabat en 1989, le Burundi s'était porté candidat à l'organisation de la seconde édition. Celle-ci tiendra donc ses assises à Bujumbura du 11 au 18 juillet 1994.

Bujumbura, ville de 300.000 habitants est située au bord du Lac Tanganyika, au fond du rift central africain qui s'étire du nord au sud, du massif du Ruwenzori au Malawi. Au mois de juillet, le temps y est sec et chaud, agréablement tempéré par la brise du lac.

Le Burundi présente des paysages variés, aux charmes discrets. A l'ouest, la crête bordière du rift où subsistent des massifs de forêt primaire culmine à plus de 2500 m d'altitude et sépare les bassins du Zaïre et du Nil. A l'est, des zones de savanes aux reliefs moins accentués annoncent déjà les grands espaces de l'Afrique orientale. Le pays est aussi un carrefour historique dont les vestiges archéologiques et la tradition orale témoignent d'un passé déjà ancien et où, au siècle dernier, se sont croisées les routes de grands explorateurs: Speke, Burton, Baumann, Livingstone, Stanley.

Le Symposium sera organisé par l'Université du Burundi en collaboration avec l'APAI (Association des Palynologues d'Afrique Intertropicale) et sous les auspices du Ministère de l'Enseignement supérieur et de la Recherche scientifique.

Cette première circulaire vous propose un programme provisoire et ses modalités d'organisation ainsi qu'un questionnaire à retourner avant le 15 mai au plus tard. Une seconde circulaire avec le programme définitif sera envoyée début septembre.

Acritarch Subcommission

1. The proceedings of the joint meeting of the acritarch and chitinozoan subcommissions, held at the British Geological Survey, Nottingham, in September 1991, are now in press. Eleven papers will be published by the Palaeontological Association in a single part of the series *Special Papers in Palaeontology*, edited by Stewart Molyneux and Ken Doring. Authors include Aicha Achab, Esther Asselin, Pavel Dufka, Stan Duxbury, Olda Fatka, Iskra Lakova, Cristiana Ribecai, Jim Riding, Claudia Rubinstein, Thomas Servais, Paul Swire, Isabel Van Waveren, Michel Vanguestaine and Milada Vavrdoová. Publication is expected within the next few months.
2. Although the subcommission was not involved in organizing any of the symposia at the 8 th IPC, acritarchs figured prominently in other sessions. Watch out for papers being edited by, among others, Alain Le Hérissé *et al.*, Verniers *et al.*, to be published in the *Review of Palaeobotany and Palynology*.
3. Alain Le Hérissé is also involved with Stewart Molyneux and Reed Wicander in preparing a chapter on 'Palaeozoic Phytoplankton' for the AASP book "Palynology and Stratigraphy". this chapter which focuses mainly on acritarchs and summarizes recent advances in Palaeozoic acritarch biostratigraphy, is now nearing completion.
4. It is intended to hold a meeting of the subcommission immediately prior to the CIMP Symposium on Stratigraphical and Environmental Palynology at Sheffield in September 1994. Further details to be announced.
